Study Guide for Nov. 21st, 2010. Questions & Answers: John 16:16-33.

Introduction: Describe a time when initial perplexity eventually gave way to clarity.

 - A. Jesus' statement that **in a little while**, the disciples will see him no more, seems clearly a reference to his departure at the crucifixion. What does the statement, **and after a little while you will see me** refer to?
 - B. What do the disciples link with the question of the meaning of after a little while?
 - C. "If Jesus wishes to found the Messianic kingdom, why go away? If He does not wish it, why return?" (Godet) What are the disciples not grasping about Jesus?
- II. The Disciples' Joy: (vs. 19-24)
 - A. What does Jesus predict will be the reaction to his departure by . . .
 - 1) ... the disciples?
 - 2) ... the world?
 - B. How does Jesus illustrate the process that will unfold with his departure / return?
 - C. Read Isaiah 26:16-21. What does the prophet predict? How is it fulfilled in Jesus?
 - D. What does Jesus envision for his disciples after his reappearance (vs. 23-24)?
- III. The Disciples' Faith: (vs. 25-30)
 - A. What does Jesus reveal about the Father and how the disciples will relate to him?
 - B. Reflect on vs. 28. What does this teach about Christ's origin, destiny, and purpose?
 - C. What do the disciples now assert about ... Jesus? ... their faith and its basis?
- IV. The Disciples' Peace: (vs. 31-33)
 - A. How does Jesus react (vs. 31-32) to the disciples' affirmation of faith (vs. 29-30)?
 - B. What can the disciples expect from the world? What assurance does Jesus give?
 - C. After Pentecost, what would be the disciples' perspective on these words of Jesus?
